RTIA Air Cargo

- Over 102 million pounds in 2009
- December 2009: +3.43% (13.1 million pounds), second highest month on record
- Approximately 14 Flights per Day
- Service by DHL, FedEx and UPS
- Southwest and Alaska/Horizon Airlines also offer cargo services
- RNO is an official diversion airport for Air China Cargo
- Before downturn, RNO experienced 32 straight months of cargo increases.



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
